Scholarship in Honor of George Geng On Lee

Capture the Dream, Inc. is offering a total of four Minorities in Leadership Scholarships to high school graduating seniors OR full-time undergraduate students enrolled at a four-year institution. Scholarship winners will receive a \$1,000 scholarship to be mailed to his/her four year accredited college or university.

Eligibility Requirements:

- All US residents are eligible. California residents are strongly encouraged to apply.
- All applicants must either be a minority high school graduating senior OR a minority full-time undergraduate student enrolled at an accredited four year-institution. (Minority is defined as a group differing from the majority population. This includes but is not limited to ethnicity, gender, religion, etc.)
- Upon winning, scholarship winners must provide verification of permanent residency (copy of US Passport or valid State ID), annual household income, and any additional documentation materials to substantiate the information provided.
- Employees of Capture the Dream, Inc. and relatives of officers are NOT eligible for this program.
- There is no application fee.

Note: A telephone or in person interview may be required for more information if you are selected as a finalist.

Application Instructions:

- Complete application based on the current school year.
- Application is not valid until ALL of the following have been completed, submitted, and received by Capture the Dream, Inc.:
 - Minorities in Leadership Scholarship Application
 - Introduction Letter to Scholarship Committee summarizing qualifications
 - Professional Resume
 - Official Transcript
 - Minorities in Leadership Scholarship Essay (1,000 words or less)
 - Financial Aid Web-Award Confirmation
 - Letter of Recommendation:
 - Minimum of 1 letter from a teacher, professor, principal, supervisor, volunteer director, or equivalent, in a sealed envelope with their signature placed across the seal.
 - This letter should address the applicant's ability to set realistic goals and how he/she has achieved them; how the applicant has demonstrated academic or community leadership; an example demonstrating the applicant's will power, personal strength, and drive; and any other relevant information.
